FROM POINTS EAST and WEST

Mass. Turnpike to Exit 6...left after toll booth (at light) onto Rte 291 West... 1 mile take East Springfield Exit...go Right at end of exit ramp...immediately get into Left lane and take a Left at the traffic light onto Roosevelt Avenue (fire station on your left)...go 3 miles (through several lights)... after going down a small hill (traffic light at bottom of the hill) go straight across a bridge staying straight once across the bridge (do not bear to the left)...the **Brennan Center** is .9 miles on Left...Parking in front of building.

FROM POINTS NORTH

Interstate Rte 91 (South) to Rte 291 Exit 2 (East)...follow Rte 291 4.2 miles to Exit 5-B...turn Right at the bottom of the exit ramp...immediately get in the Left lane and take a Left at the traffic light onto Roosevelt Avenue (fire station on left)...go 3 miles (through several lights)...after going down a small hill (traffic light at the bottom of the hill) go straight across a bridge staying straight once across the bridge (do not bear to the left)...the **Brennan Center** is .9 miles on the Left...Parking in front of building.

FROM POINTS SOUTH

Interstate Rte 91 (North) to Exit 2...go up ramp and follow to 2nd traffic light...go Right at light onto Sumner Ave...follow 2.1 miles (through several lights) and turn Left onto Roosevelt Avenue...take a Left at next traffic light (immediately after turn) onto Allen St...follow to second traffic light .7 miles and take a right onto Island Pond Rd...**Brennan Center** in immediately on your Right...parking in front of building.
